This position includes, but is not limited to, the following responsibilities:

Listen to clientele, build networks to assess locals needs and collaborate with communities of people.
- Reach youth and adult audiences. Be a voice in mass and social media outreach.
- Share leadership of Eddy and Foster County 4-H programs including the development of 4-H volunteers.
- Willing and able to travel and adjust to a flexible schedule (i.e., participate in evening and weekend programs).

Minimum Qualifications

1. Bachelor's degree in human development, family and consumer sciences, education, health and nutrition, gerontology or a related field, OR a bachelor's degree with work experience related to the position or a related master's degree.
2. Ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with colleagues, partners, and stakeholders.
3. Basic computer skills and ability to use Microsoft office programs such as Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
4. Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, with individuals, groups and through mass media.
