MINUTES OF THE EDDY COUNTY WATER RESOURCE BOARD February 4, 2025

A regular meeting of the Eddy County Water Resource Board was held on February 4, 2025 at 10:00 AM at the Eddy County Courthouse. Eddy County landowner, Roger Langley, was also present.

The minutes of the regular January 7, 2025 meeting were presented. Tweed made a motion to approve. Second by Schaefer. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was presented and reviewed. Schaefer made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. Reis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The current Bank Forward 7-month certificate of deposit #86862 matured on February 2, 2025. Renewal terms were discussed. Schaefer made a motion to move the entire value (principal and interest) of the current certificate of deposit #86862 into a new 13-month certificate of deposit at the current rate of 4%. Second by Tweed. Motion carried.

Roger Langley: Langley was present to revisit his County Road #4 water frustrations. Langley wants to block water from flowing south in the ditch west of County Road #4. A suggestion was made that Langley construct a dike on his land with flap gate in order to channel the water down the ditch. Langley does not like this idea. Langley left the meeting, and no further action was taken.
