Lisa Thompson, Emergency Manager gave an update on the FEMA grants, both grants that were applied for were awarded. New quotes are needed as previous quotes were received in April, both grants were under \$10,000. The security camera quote from NDTC was \$9,999.27 and waiting on new quote from for metal door. Thompson also reported that HUD has new guidance requirements for the Floodplain Ordinances, and the approved Ordinance "D" will need to be modified in March of 2025.

Todd Weber, Road Superintendent gave an update on the County Road Department. The City of New Rockford has agreed to take the generator that was previously given to the City of Sheyenne. It was previously considered out of service, but Weber reported that it does run. Weber inquired about joining Sourcewell — a purchasing coop that streamlines the procurement process. Weber also discussed replacing the county's skid steer. Weber reported that there are approximately 1350 hours on current skid steer and cost for new skid steer with trade in is \$99,117.00.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to sign on with Sourcewell and to move forward with the trade in on a new skid steer. Glenda Collier seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Todd Allmaras addressed the Commission with information regarding on the SIRN radio project. There is a grant available for up to \$1,500 per radio, which is set to end March 31, 2025. Allmaras suggested that plow trucks should have radios. Weber would prefer to have portable radios. Allmaras discussed safety concerns surrounding the Munster School property. Allmaras suggested that the area of the old school house be filled and covered. He suggested a 50/50 cost share between Eddy County and New Rockford Sheyenne School. Allmaras will solicit bids and return to Commission for further discussion.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to order 4 portable radios for the Road Department. Glenda Collier seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Roger Langley presented information to the Commission on a Stream Cross Study and asked if Eddy County would consider requesting a Study. State's Attorney Lies advised Langley that Eddy County is not requesting a stream study at this time and that he can request the study with the approval of the surrounding landowners or request a steam study from the Water Board.

Kevin Johnson was present to discuss lawn mowing at the Fairgrounds. The annual cost of lawn mowing for the season is \$1,500. The cost of water at the fairgrounds during ND Steam Threshers was \$408.21. The difference between the cost to mow \$1,500 and the cost of water \$408.21 is \$1,091.79.

Glenda made a motion to pay CNDSTR \$1,091.79 for mowing the fairgrounds this season. Dave Gehrtz seconded the motion. All were in favor, motion carried.

Old Business:

Glenda Collier made a motion to approve the Brady Martz Annual Audit for 2023. Dave Gehrtz seconded the motion. All were in favor, motion carried.

Glenda Collier made a motion to amend the Delinquent Tax Sale price to be sold as the total tax due, including liens. Dave Gehrtz seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

There were no public comments heard at the Public Hearing for the Zoning Flood Plain Ordinance Model "D". Dave Gehrtz made a motion to approve the Zoning Flood Plain Model "D" Ordinance. Glenda Collier seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

There we no public comments heard at the Public Hearing for Amending the Zoning Ordinance to add additional options for variance requests. Glenda Collier made a motion to approve the Zoning Ordinances adding additional options for variance requests. Dave Gehrtz seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to approve the increase in contract with Randy Linderman from \$2,000 per month to \$2,100 per month with the inclusion of the Public Health Office. Glenda Collier seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

New Business:

Tiffany Harr presented quotes for a new Clerk of Court desk in the courtroom. The court facilities grant will be applied for, for desk. If the grant is awarded the cost to Eddy County will be around \$790.75. The desk is shorter in length and dept, making it easier and safer to move in the Court Room.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to approve applying for grant for the desk. Glenda Collier seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

The Eddy County Christmas Party was set for December 4, 2024 at the County Shop.

Annual service awards were discussed. Dave Gehrtz made a motion to approve a sweatshirt and \$50 in Chamber Bucks for Eddy County Employees. Glenda Collier seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Glenda Collier made a motion to approve the Lease Agreement for the Fairgrounds for Shalya Thumb and Samuel Krause's Wedding on August 20, 2025 – August 24, 2025. Dave Gehrtz seconded the motion, all were in favor. Motion carried.

Glenda Collier made a motion to approve the Liquior and Beer License for the New Rockford Golf Course. Dave Gehrtz seconded the motion. All were in favor, motion carried.

Dave Gehrtz made a motion to change the Eddy County Courthouse and Buildings afternoon hours on Friday to 1:00 P.M. Glenda Collier seconded the motion. In discussion, it was directed that hourly employees will need to make up the hours during the week and if there is work scheduled or needed to be completed, employees will be expected to be present to preform those tasks. In a vote, all were in favor, motion carried.

With no further business, Dave Gehrtz made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:52 AM.
